Important Information:

If you have transfer credits in Anatomy and Physiology I & II, Microbiology, Introduction to Psychology, or Human Growth and Development, they must be no more than five years old from the start of the first nursing course with a minimum grade of 'C+'. We will not accept these courses if you took them before fall 2016; you will have to retake them.



Advanced Placement for Licensed Practical Nurses

Licensed Practical Nurses (LPN's) may have the opportunity to transfer into the ASN program with advanced standing in the spring semester of the first year on a space available basis. Deadline for admission to the spring 2021 semester is November 1,2020.





Selection Criteria

Selection is determined by a cumulative point based system that looks at applicable courses and grades; TEAS scores and references. The Vice President of Student and Community Affairs and the Chair of the Department of Nursing will review applications and make the admission decisions. Preference will be given to applicants who:

- Are New Hampshire residents
- Have higher grades for A&P I and II
