Supples are located in their own tool cart. Seestructor for the cart.

- 1. Secure a sanitizing wipe/ spray bottled apaper towels
- 2. Walk outside to vehicle. Customerehicles must be cleaned before entering thisding
- 3. Starting at the left rear door, wipe down the door handle.
- 4. Proceed to the trunk lid where you will wipe the trunk latch.
- 5. Proceed to the right rear door and wipe down the door handle.
- 6. Proceed to the right front door and wipe down the door handle
- 7. Proceed to the $\vec{\mathbf{D}}$ ver door and wipe down that handle.
- 8. Open the door, and wipe down the inside door handle, the steering wheel, the gear shifter, and any otherus face you may need to come in contact with during yourk wn this vehicle.
- 9. Install steering wheel covers, shifter covers and seat covers.
- 10. When cleane the vehicle can be pulled into the shop.
- 11. If using a wipe, dispose of it in the trash.
- 12. Proceed with yor work on the vehicle.

At checkout, whoever will get to Q(Quality Control) the customer's veble will do the following:

If a student was the only oneworking on theirown car there is no need wripe down. If another studentwas working on the car wipebown any areas they may haved bed.

- 1. Perform the QC stepbland prints, boot prints, inspect work completed etc.
- 2. When finished with the QC steps, secure a Clorox wiprean Isopropyl Alcohol Mister, and paper towels.
- 3. Park vehicle for customer pickup
- 4. Wipe down the inside doorandle, the steering wheel, the gerafter, and any other surface you may have come in contwirth during your work on this vehicle.
- 5. Wipe down customer's car keys and return to the unstor.
- 6. When using a wipe, dispose of it in the trash.
