

AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN (ARP)
HIGHER EDUCATION EMERGENCY RELIEF FUND (HEERF III)

The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund III (HEERF III) is authorized by the American Rescue Plan (ARP), Public Law 117-2 which was signed into law on March 11, 2021. ARP funds are in addition to funds authorized by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA), Public Law 116-260 and the Coronavirus Aid, Recovery, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, Public Law 116-136.

Institutions which received HEERF I Grant Funds under the CARES Act were not required to apply for the HEERF III Grant. Rather, the terms and conditions governing the institution use of these supplemental grant funds awarded pursuant to section 2003 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) (Pub. L. 117-2) (supplemental award or grant) by the U.S. Department of Education (Department) are governed by section 2003 of the ARP and 314 of the CRRSAA (Pub. L. 116-260) and the terms and conditions of the Supplemental Agreement N4.76 2 0 612 792 reW6 g38 Tm0.0118 0.0392 0.
