

Standard 5.1 – Pre-Admission Program Advisement

When students show interest in the programs at NCC they are asked a few key questions. These are as follow:

1. What program are you interested in?
2. Where do you see yourself working? (Dealer or independent shop)
3. Where do you live?

These questions allow us to point them to the right program as well as give us an opportunity to start the conversation of where they might be able to work. There are many resources here at the college beyond program faculty that can help with pre-program advisement. These include:
